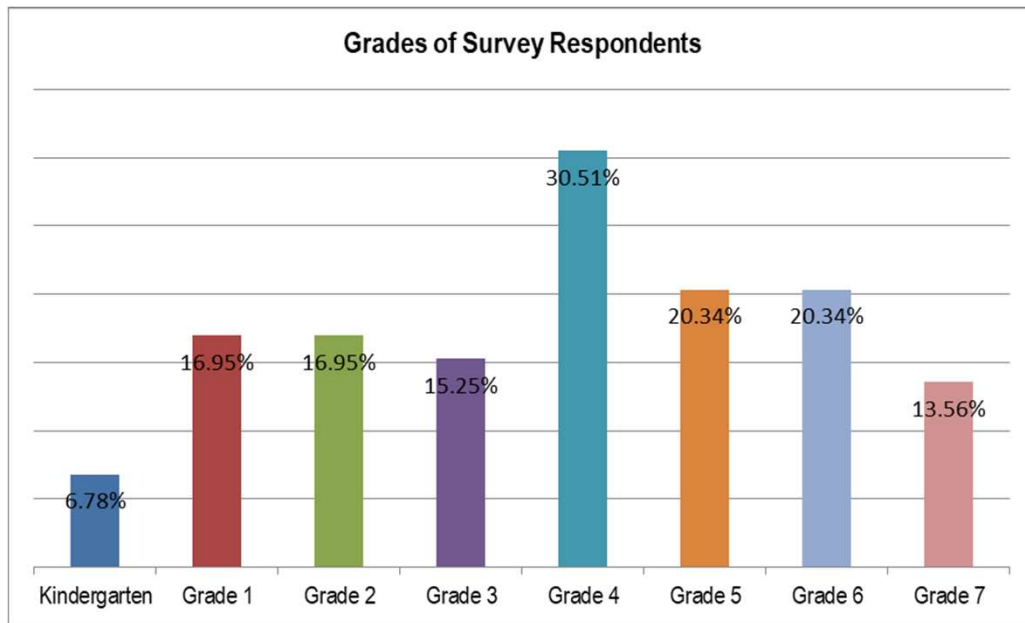
Background

- ▶ The Montroyal Parent Advisory Council (MPAC) Feedback survey was open to parents from May 2nd until May 9th
- ▶ The survey was accessible through an e-mail that went out to all Montroyal parents that are part of the MPAC Communications e-mail distribution list
- ▶ The information gathered from this survey will be used to support the PAC Executive in preparing budgets and priorities for the 2018/2019 school year

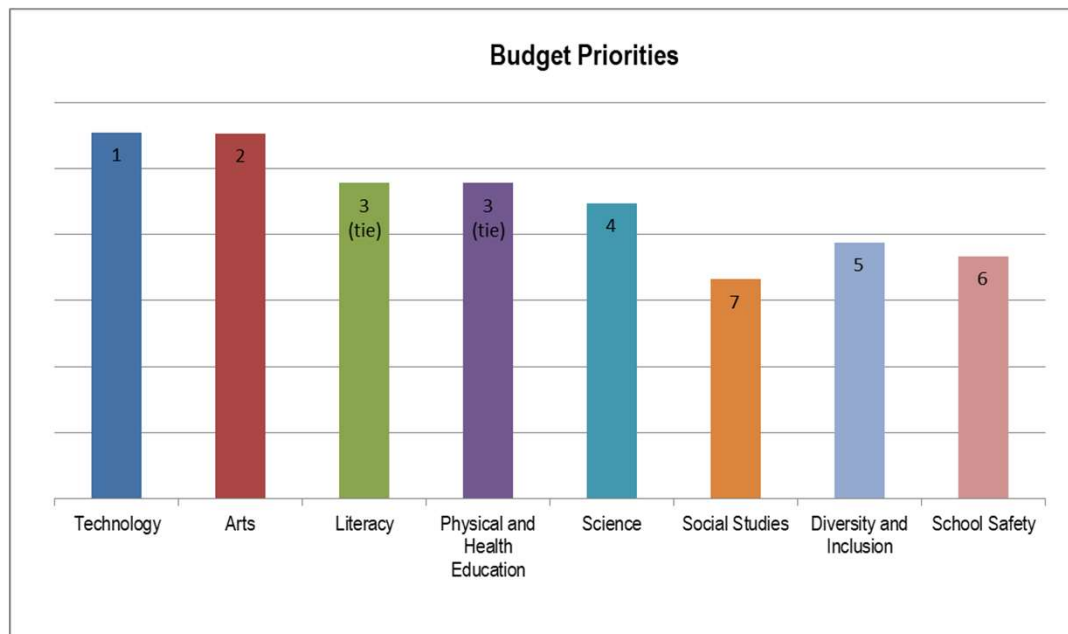
Participation

- ▶ The survey went out to 220 parents with a final participation rate of 27% (60 respondents)
- ▶ Of the 60 respondents, the below table provides a breakdown of their children's grades



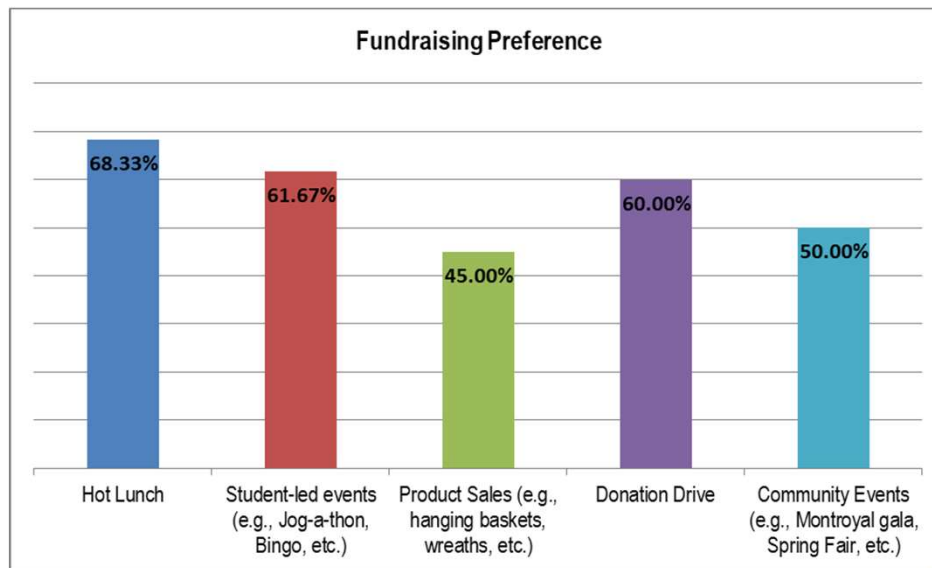
Budget Priorities - Summary

- ▶ Respondents were asked to rank 8 areas of focus in terms how they wanted to see the budget prioritized for the next school year
- ▶ Examples of how funds may have been allocated to these areas in the past was provided for reference and can be seen in the detailed results



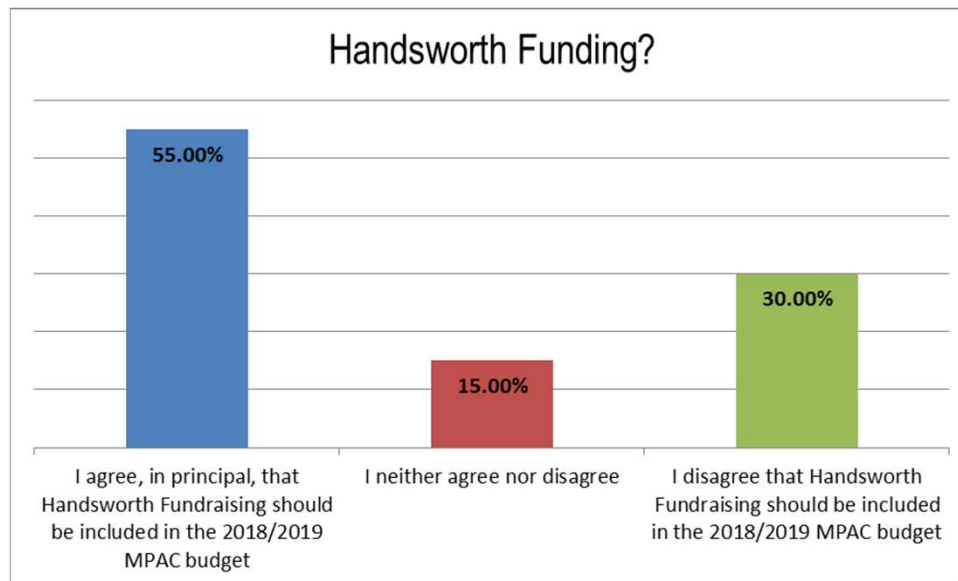
Fundraising Preference - Summary

- ▶ Respondents were asked to indicate their preferences for fundraising based on a list of how funds have been raised in previous years
- ▶ Of the 60 respondents, HotLunch was the most preferred method for fundraising with Student-led Events and Donation Drive following closely behind

Handsworth Funding

- ▶ Respondents were asked whether they agreed, in principal, that a small percentage of MPAC 2018/2019 budget should be allocated to the future rebuild of Handsworth Secondary School
- ▶ It should be noted that while the majority of the 60 respondents agreed with the Handsworth funds allocation, the MPAC Team will continue to work with feeder schools to find out what this may look like as well as keep the broader PAC up to date on the overall process to ensure parents can be involved in the final decision
