1. Email Denise Howell denise.howell@shaw.ca with your name and a description of the item(s) that you'd like to sell - remember it's mainly kids doing the shopping!! There will be a limit on candy tables so be creative and crafty! Maximum 2 sellers per table.
2. Drop your payment (cash, or cheque payable to 'Montroyal PAC') in the PAC box in the school lobby, in an envelope marked 'Holiday Market' by Nov 27.
