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Kiln – Reported at the start of the year was not function properly by the grade one staff. The recommendation was to replace for \$5000.00 to support in-curricular art projects. The MPAC executive has decided to work with a local pottery supply company to repair the unit and assess if new unit is required for next year. This item is primary used by the younger grades; however, the administration will use a school professional development day to train inexperienced pottery staff to increase its use.

iPads – We currently have a ½ set of iPads which the kindergarten / grade 1 students share. Based on the feedback from the administration they are well used and the MPAC executive has decided to add an additional full set to the cart. This will increase the technology usage in the primary grades and will support the in curricular coding lessons starting in the 2018-2019 school year.

Front Row Sound System – Montroyal staff currently have 3 units and staff is reporting these assists in teaching and helps reduce voice strain. This product also improves the students' ability to hear the lesson as well is beneficial for those students with hearing impairments. This large investment of over \$2000 to one class lead to the decision to phase in slowly and promote staff to hold in-services on the technology to increase interest for future wish lists. Currently our staff do not use these units to the full potential; they also can record lessons which could mean absent students receive the same teaching and staff no longer need to adjust their lessons based on band, strings and gifted program.

Chick Ball – This addition to our gym equipment will provide staff with additional games for PE class.

Pioneer Educational Globes – Ms. Gill's National Geographic designation has provided our school with a resource for geography. The staff felt that improved atlas and globes would assist in their teachings. The school district is providing the atlases as a part of the text book fund and the MPAC will provide 2 globes, one of each polar orientation that will be kept in the library for staff to borrow for their geography lessons.

Electric Pencil Sharpeners – Staff has reported that there is a loss of productivity in the class due to the need to sharpen pencils and pencil crayons. These electric sharpeners stop when the pencil is sharp, so students do not use it as a toy. The MPAC executive has decided to phase in this item with 3 this year providing us time to assess the quality of the product and the benefits to the classroom.

Sport Jerseys – Our team uniforms have seen better days and we will keep the old uniforms as back up but purchase new uniforms with our new school mascot. Purchasing in multiple styles provide adaptability for various sports, body types and gender. The T-Shirts will ensure that all our track and field members are in one style and colour of shirt.

Listening centres for iPad cart – Ms. Hill recommended 2 listening carts for the library. This will supplement the guided reading program as well as provide an additional activity for class book exchange times shots.

Our total spend is \$9,641, orders will be placed in late June with deliver in August to benefit the start of the 2018-2019 school year. Motion to approve the 2017-2018 Wish List.
