    - District engineer confirmed numerous safety concerns requiring immediate removal on a PD day
    - D. Beveridge says PAC meeting to discuss options desired, confirms
      District support acknowledging high costs
  - D. Beveridge highlights Family Affordability Fund for any families with need, asks them to reach out to him directly.
  - D. Beveridge thanks parents for Parent Teacher interviews, asks to connect with teacher if incompleted
  - D. Beveridge shares earthquake drill scheduled for October 20, 2022, shares first fire drill: <2min school evacuation, <7min complete headcount</li>
  - Looking for PAC members to assist with School Plan; asking for PAC to identify parents and students to assist; interested parents should speak with D.
     Beveridge
    - D. Beveridge asks for 3 PAC members for School Plan Meetings (2 between now and April) 3:45-6:30pm
  - D. Beveridge confirms D. Palgova's absence from office, email unanswered emails forward to him
  - D. Beveridge reminds of early release next week, report cards in December
