General Information

Please keep this page for your reference and review with your child prior to the first lesson.

TIMES:

- 3:25 – 3:35 Base check in for students **renting equipment**. Montroyal Host will escort students to the rental chalet, assist with rental and transfer to the Grouse instructor for 4:30 lesson start time
- 3:35 – 3:50 Base check in for students **NOT** renting equipment. Montroyal Host will escort students to the lesson area and transfer to the Grouse instructor for 4:30 lesson start time. Please keep in mind we have to sign in 30-40 children so please do not arrive at the last minute.
- 4:30 Montroyal Hosts will hand off the students to Grouse Mountain instructors outside of the lesson shack. Students will be divided into their respective groups. Volunteers may utilize their free ticket at this time.
- 4:30 – 6:00 Ski/ Snowboard lesson. Student will be met by the volunteer Hosts at the end of the lesson. Attendance will be checked at this point.
- 6:00 - 6:30 Montroyal Host will escort the students on the gondola down the mountain and students **MUST** check out at the base of the mountain. Check out at approx. 6:30

Note: If your child arrives after 3:50 and the check in is closed, it is your responsibility to escort your child to the instructor outside the lesson shack. Your child must be there before the group departs. No refunds will be issued if your child is late and the group has left.

Important notices:

- Students **MUST** check-in at the base of Grouse Mountain. Montroyal parent volunteers will have a table outside of Starbucks where students will be given a badge.
- Transportation to the base of Grouse Mountain is the responsibility of the parent. We encourage carpooling as parking is extremely limited.
- Helmets **MUST** be worn during the lesson for safety. Helmets are available for rent from Grouse Mountain.
- Mountain weather conditions should be reviewed prior to the lesson however conditions can change quickly so please prepare for all weather conditions. We suggest students bring the following items: 1) waterproof pants and jacket 2) thermal base layers (top and bottom) 3) Fleece jacket 4) Turtle neck, neck warmer or scarf 5) hat 6) gloves and spare pair 7) warm socks 8) goggles 9) helmet 10) water bottle and 11) peanut free snack.

- Due to liability issues, Montroyal students will not be permitted to stay on the top of Grouse Mountain after their lesson unless one of the parents is at the top of the mountain after the lesson to sign them out.
- Students over the age of 12 may sign themselves out of the lesson if a written consent from the parent(s) is on file before or on the first day of the club or at least 24 hrs to the day it applies to. No exceptions will be made. Consent instruction sheet is [here](#).
- Please e-mail club coordinator before 2 pm if your child will miss that day's lesson.
- Skiing and snowboarding have the potential for injury. Our Montroyal volunteers have a duty to take responsible care of your child however, MPAC and MPAC volunteers are not liable for injury or for lost or stolen items.
- Note that cell reception is very poor up Grouse Mountain. There are, however, pay phones in the chalet at the summit.
